ORDINANCE #45

DEPUTY

The Board of Commissioners for Tillamook County ordains as follows:

Section 1. No person shall operate a commercial parking lot, or collect fees for the parking of motor vehicles, or otherwise allow the parking of motor vehicles for a fee or charge on any grounds used or occupied by the county fair, or within one-half mile of such grounds, without having first obtained from the County Board of Commissioners a license for the privilege, or obtained the written consent of the County Board of Commissioners.

Section 2. Nothing contained in Section 1 shall restrain any person except during the sessions of the annual fair or other public event or meetings and for two days prior and two days subsequent thereto; nor shall it extend to the County Fair Board or any person regularly and continuously carrying on such a legally established business within one-half mile of the premises mentioned.

Section 3. Enforcement and Penalties

A. This ordinance shall be enforced under and pursuant to the provisions of Planning and Zoning Ordinance No. 35, the uniform citation ordinance.

B. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance is guilty of a violation. Failure from day to day to comply with the terms of this ordinance shall be a separate offense for each such day. Failure to comply with any provision of this ordinance shall be a separate offense for each such provision.

C. Violations of the provisions of this ordinance are punishable, upon conviction by a fine of not less than Fifty (\$50) Dollars nor more than Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars for a single non-continuing offense, i.e., an offense not spanning two (2) or more calendar days. In the case of a continuing offense, i.e., an offense which spans two (2) or more consecutive calendar days, violation of a provision of this ordinance is punishable by a fine of not less than Fifty (\$50) Dollars per day up to the maximum of One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars as provided by law.

Section 4. The Board of Commissioners finds that the operation of unregulated parking lots and parking areas in the vicinity of the County fairgrounds during the County Fair and other public events at the fairgrounds:

- A. Creates additional congestion and traffic hazards on and along those thoroughfares leading to and from the fairgrounds;
- B. Produces land use conflicts for the residential uses in the vicinity of the fairgrounds; and
- C. Presents an unreasonable risk to public safety and welfare.

Section 5. As a consequence of the findings set forth in Section 4, the Board finds that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation and protection of the public health, safety and welfare. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
