And Repealing Certain Sections Thereof) ORDINANCE NO. 37

The Board of County Commissioners of Tillamook County, Oregon, ordains as follows:

Section I.

Ordinance No. 37 is amended to read: "Forfeiture proceedings brought pursuant to this Ordinance shall be subject to the procedures and limitations set forth in ORS Chapter 475A and the Oregon Constitution, Article XV, Section 10".

Section II.

Sections II, III, IV, V, VI, VII, and VIII are repealed.

Section III.


This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

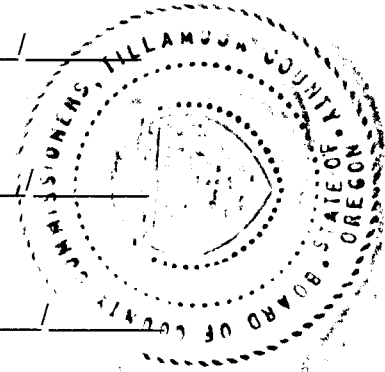


