ORDINANCE NO. 26

WHEREAS, the People of Tillamook County on November 6, 1984, adopted a Measure which had been placed on the election ballot by initiative petition; now, therefore

The People of Tillamook County, Oregon, ordain as follows, effective November 6, 1984:

Tillamook County shall be designated a nuclear weapons free zone.

1. It shall be unlawful in Tillamook County, Oregon, to reseach, develop, test, evaluate, produce, maintain, store and/or transport nuclear weaponry or armaments, or any component parts integrally associated therewith, including, but not limited to delivery, guidance, and/or triggering mechanisms, nor shall such items be situated, for any duration of time, within the county limits.
2. This ordinance shall not be construed to prohibit the use of radioactive materials in existing or future medical, scientific, or industrial non-weapons related research or application.
3. Each violation of this ordinance shall be a Class A misdemeanor. Each day of the violation shall be interpreted as a separate violation.


