ORDINANCE NO. ● 9

(AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE
(OF A MAP SETTING FORTH AN ADDRESSING
(GRID FOR TILLAMOOK COUNTY AND PROVID-
(ING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ISSUANCE OF AN
(ADDRESS NUMBER.

The Board of County Commissioners for Tillamook County, Oregon ordains as follows:

SECTION 101. SHORT TITLE

This ordinance shall be known as the "Tillamook County House Numbering Ordinance".

SECTION 102. TABLE OF CONTENTS

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SECTION 103. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide an orderly manner of designating a numerical addressing system for all buildings, as defined herein, in order to facilitate the immediate location of these buildings by the various emergency and support services in Tillamook County, and local residents.

SECTION 104. SCOPE

- 104. This ordinance shall apply to:
 - 104.1 Property owners in all unincorporated areas of Tillamook County, on whose property now exists a building as defined herein.
 - 104.2 Property owners in all unincorporated areas of Tillamook County who may hereinafter apply for a permit to construct or place a building as defined herein, within Tillamook County.
 - 104.3 This numbering system was established for Tillamook County. However, if individual incorporated cities wish to participate they may do so in the future without duplication of numbers.

SECTION 105. DEFINITIONS

105. The following definitions shall apply to this ordinance:

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- 105.1 Building: Any residential, commercial or industrial structure to include but not limited to mobile homes and temporary recreation vehicles, located within the unincorporated areas of Tillamook County.
- 105.2 Temporary Recreation Vehicle: A recreation vehicle placed on a lot not inside a trailer park or camping park for seasonal or vacation use, within the unincorporated areas of Tillamook County.
- 105.3 Mobile Home: Means a vehicular or portable structure having a minimum of 600 square feet of floor area which is constructed for movement on the public highways; which is designed for use as a residence but which has not been demonstrated to conform to the requirements of the building code for other residences.
- 105.4 Recreation Vehicle: Means a vacation trailer or other vehicular or portable unit which either self propelled or towed or is carried by a motor vehicle and which is intended for human occupancy and is designed for vacation or recreation purposes but not residential use.
- 105.5 Baseline: Imaginary lines running north-south and east-west from the centroid from which a numbering or renumbering system along roadways shall begin.
- 105.6 Centroid: The point at which the north-south and east-west baselines intersect.

SECTION 106. GRID SYSTEM

- 106.1 The house numbering system for Tillamook County utilizes a grid pattern with each grid line running along the section and half section lines.
- 106.2 Two baselines shall be established that will divide Tillamook County into four quadrants being north, south, northwest and southwest.
- 106.3 Wilson River Highway (State Highway 6) is utilized as the north-south baseline from which address numbers will increase numerically from the baseline south and from the baseline north.
- 106.4 The east-west baseline is established off the coast at a point approximately one half mile west of Cascade Head Point running in a northerly direction in the ocean and ending approximately two and one half miles west of Cape Falcon Point. (With the exception of zip code area 97141 and zip code area 97134 which has the base line running along the Tillamook River and out Tillamook Bay).

106.5 The numbering system shall designate odd numbers ie. 28375 for buildings on the south and east sides of a roadway and even numbers ie. 28370 for buildings on the north and west sides of a roadway.

SECTION 107. PROCEDURES

107. The following procedures shall apply when issuing a house number or updating house numbering maps:
- 107.1 The postal service or other services in cooperation with Tillamook County Planning Department shall issue house numbers for all existing buildings on their present rural routes within the inincorporated areas of Tillamook County.
- 107.2 In the absence of a postal service designation for a building within the scope of this ordinance, the property owner shall apply to the Planning Department for said address number.
- 107.3 The Planning Department shall be responsible for designating all new addresses on the building permits or trailer placement permits as they are issued and denote said number on the appropriate house numbering map.
- 107.4 The house numbering maps shall be maintained by the Tillamook County Planning Department, and shall be updated for various postal or emergency services periodically.
- 107.5 Individual grid maps will be made available at cost from the Tillamook County Planning Department.

SECTION 108. PLACEMENT

- 108.1 Tillamook County recommends the use of numerals 3" in width and 4" in height of contrasting colors to be placed so that they can be seen from the roadway to facilitate location of your building by emergency equipment operators. However, placement of the house numbers shall conform to the Postal Service Rule 156.52 Painting and Identification.

SECTION 109. ADOPTION

109. This ordinance shall be in force from and after the 25th day of April, 1978.
