THIS MATTER CAME BEFORE THE Tillamook County Board of Commissioners, on January 16, 2019 at the request of Chris Laity, Director of Public Works, for a portion of Twelfth Street to be approved by the Board for jurisdiction transfer to the City of Tillamook in accordance with ORS 373.270. That section of Twelfth Street is further described as follows:

A strip of land located in Section 30 of Township 1 South, Range 9 West of the Willamette Meridian and being further described as:

All that strip of land being of varied widths lying west of a line beginning on the north right-of-way line of Twelfth Street, which lies North 163.51 feet and West 1276.63 feet from the Southeast corner of Section 30 and running Southerly, perpendicular to the South line of Twelfth Street.

The Board being fully advised in the premises, records and files herein, makes the following findings:

1. The portion of road described above has recently been improved to standards that the City of Tillamook City Manager has indicated the city can accept as a city road.
2. Notice of this hearing was properly given under ORS 373.270(2).
3. The public hearing was held as scheduled and the Board heard the matter and considered any objections or testimony offered by interested persons.
4. The Board of Commissioners deems it necessary, expedient and in the best interest of Tillamook County to transfer jurisdiction of the portion of Twelfth Street as described above to the City of Tillamook.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

5. The jurisdiction over the portion of Twelfth Street described above shall be offered to the City of Tillamook.

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6. Upon the passage of a resolution by the City of Tillamook accepting said transfer the full and absolute jurisdiction over the road for all purposes of repair, construction, improvement and the levying and collection of assessments therefore shall vest in the City of Tillamook.

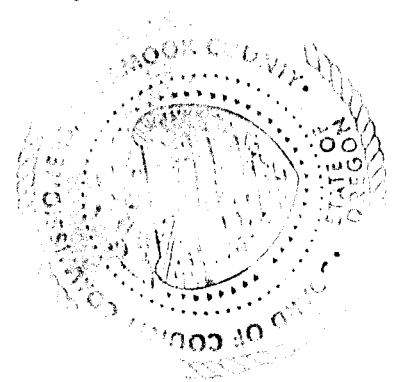
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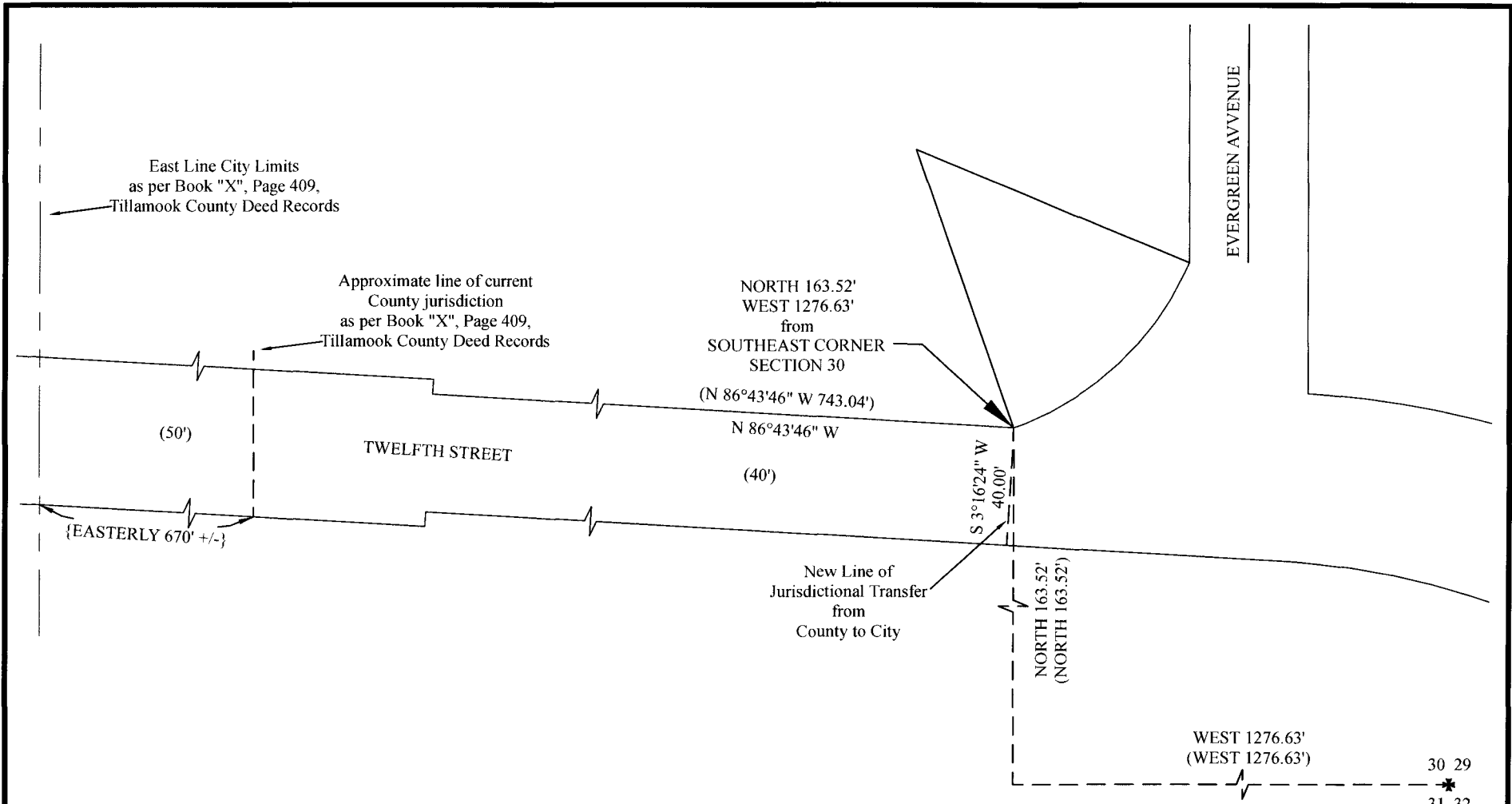

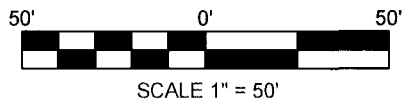
