- 1. DEQ's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) program offers below-market rate loans and bond purchases to public agencies for planning, design, construction and implementation of water quality improvement projects.
- 2. A SRF loan application was submitted by the Tillamook County Solid Waste Service District in 2022, with a loan offer awarded in early 2023. These partially forgivable funds will enable the county to access the necessary capital funds to invest in aging infrastructure and increase collection and sorting capacity at the Pacific City transfer station. The total loan amount is \$1,753,883.
- 3. In order to proceed, the county needs to authorize the execution and delivery of the loan agreement and all other documents and instruments necessary to obtain the loan.
