This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on April 3, 2024, at the request of Rachel Hagerty, Chief of Staff. The Board of Commissioners being fully apprised of the above-named person, the records and files herein, finds as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to ORS 198.345(1), on August 18, 2023, the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners received notice from the Office of the Oregon Secretary of State that the Beaver Water District failed for three consecutive years to file the reports required by municipal audit law.
- 2. The State's notice requests the Board initiate dissolution proceedings under the provisions of ORS 198.335 to 198.365.
- 3. Pursuant to ORS 198.345(2), on August 24, 2023, the Board of Commissioners' Office informed the Beaver Water District of the State's notice and the statutory process for dissolution, thereby initiating dissolution proceedings.
- On September 24, 2023, the District provided the Board of Commissioners' Office the required District financial statement prescribed in ORS 198.350.
- 5. On November 1, 2023, pursuant to ORS 198.355, the Board held a public hearing on the question of dissolving the District. The Board determined that the District is operating as an active district and that there is a need for the district, and thus continued the hearing pursuant to ORS 198.360 until the reports required under ORS 294.458 and 297.405 to 297.555 are properly filed. The Board continued the hearing to January 17, 2024.
- During the hearing continued to January 17, 2024, the Board acknowledged the District's progress in gaining statutory compliance and determined that the District is still operating as an active district and that there is still a need for the district, and thus continued the hearing pursuant to ORS 198.360 until the reports required under ORS 294.458 and 297.405 to 297.555 are properly filed. The board continued the hearing to April 3, 2024.
- 7. On April 1, 2024, the Office of the Oregon Secretary of State informed the Board of Commissioners' Office that the District is only two consecutive years delinquent in filing the reports required by municipal audit law.

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 8. The Beaver Water District has filed three of the five outstanding reports required under ORS 294.458 and 297.405 to 297.555.
- 9. All further dissolution proceedings under ORS 198.345 to 198.365 are hereby terminated.
